Dear Members of Ogbakor Ikwerre USA/Canada:

Please accept on my behalf & that of the EC our sincere compliments of the season for a Happy and prosperous New Year. We remain very appreciative of God's divine intervention in all things concerning us so far and hopeful that the New Year will bring us abundance of good tidings.

I am happy to announce formally that OIUSA 2018 National Convention will take place at the Detroit Metro Airport Marriott, 30559 Flynn Drive, Romulus, MI, 48174 on Friday, May 25th. – Sunday May 27th. Michigan happens to be my (Mr. President's) home state and I look forward to seeing you all. The EC agreed to host the Convention in May because the Memorial weekend always had the Monday as holiday and so gives you one extra day to travel. Although you have earlier received information of the venue and Hotels information, we still urge you to start making arrangements to travel to Michigan now, because May is just around the corner.

This year's Convention Theme, "Accelerating Community & Youth Empowerment Projects in the Niger Delta, through private and public sector initiatives," is aimed at calling all public and private business institutions that have footprints in Ikwerre land and beyond to consciously consider the impacts of their economic and environmental activities on their Ikwerre "landlords. The overall goal is to use the potential partnership agreement to enact specific remedies to mitigate the obvious negative impacts on our teeming but restive young population.

The Michigan Convention will feature three speeches. Two of those speeches will be from private sectors representatives on how they can partner with OIUSA/Canada to support and sustain our programs through grants, donations and expert advice. The two organizations are the NDDC and The Ford Foundation. Our programs: The Obi Wali Research Endowment funds, the Skills Acquisition and craft center, scholarship awards and Health Outreach will be the focal points. These programs address the problems that impact our teeming young population and enact ultimate potential measures to enhance their upward mobility while discouraging their restiveness. A successful partnership initiative with both organizations will keep OIUSA solvent, thereby eliminating obvious funding problems.

The third speech, our Keynote Address titled "Protecting Ikwerre Identity (Unity) in an era of toxic political power play" will be delivered by our premier President, Darlington Didia, Ph.D. Dear brothers and sisters you'll agree with me that this topic which touches us most, and have remained largely ignored must be addressed.
