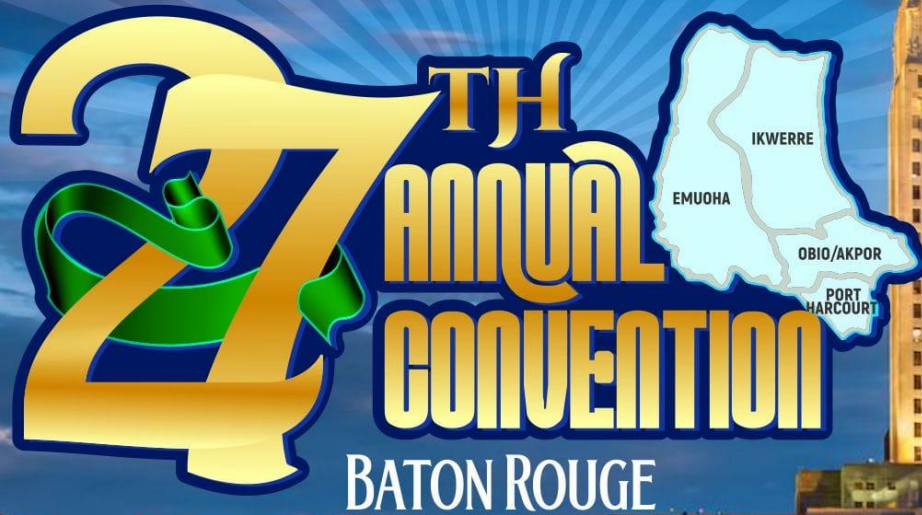

On behalf of the Executive Committee of OIUSA/Canada, we wish you and your families a Merry Christmas and Happy New Year in advance.

I am delighted to announce that the 2023 Ogbakor Iwhuruohna USA (OIUSA)/Canada, Inc. Annual Convention will be held at the **Holiday Inn, Baton Rouge South, from May 26-28, 2023**. In keeping with our tradition, the National Convention Planning Committee (NCPC) has done a great job in finalizing accommodation and lodging arrangements for the convention, giving everyone sufficient time and information to facilitate travel plans.

This convention will differ from the past, but you have to be there to find out. The Hotel offers special discounted rates to members and guests who make their **reservations on or before April 26, 2023**. - The rate includes breakfast on Saturday and Sunday- buffet style in front of the meeting space.
- The Hotel will convert two standard king rooms into suites, creating three suites from it.
- The check-in time is 3:00 PM, and the check-out time is 12:00 PM. Early Check-in based on availability.
- The Hotel will honor the rates three days before and after the event.
- Notice of individual's cancellation must be received at least 48 hours prior to scheduled arrival.
- Billing is not final until final check-out-subject to change for any charges not available at this time, such as calls, room service, gift shop charges, final consumption charges, etc.

## **NOTE:**

### **Individuals to pay own:**

Members and guests are required to pay their account upon departure. When you make your reservations, the Hotel will require a deposit equal to the room rate and tax for the first night of each reservation. An individual's deposit is refundable to that individual if the Hotel receives notice of an individual's cancellation at least **72 hours** before scheduled arrival. *Upon check-in, the guest will be required to present a valid credit card, on which an amount of sufficient pre-authorization can be obtained to cover the room and tax charges for the length of the guest's stay, plus the anticipated use of the Hotel's ancillary services.*



**Arrival & Departure Dates:**

The National Convention Planning Committee (NCPC) has arranged with the hotel management to allow convention attendees *arriving or departing two days before or after the convention* to benefit from the Hotel’s discounted rate. This arrangement will allow members to enjoy your Louisiana experience and its surrounding tourist attractions.

**Convention Pre-registration:**

Members, prospective members, and guests are encouraged to pre-register for the convention online or by mail conveniently. Doing so will help you to avoid queuing up in a possibly long line at the registration desk during the convention, as this convention is expected to draw record attendance. For all early registration, your receipts will be mailed to you by the OIUSA Financial Team on or before April 30, 2023.
